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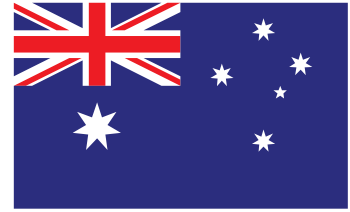
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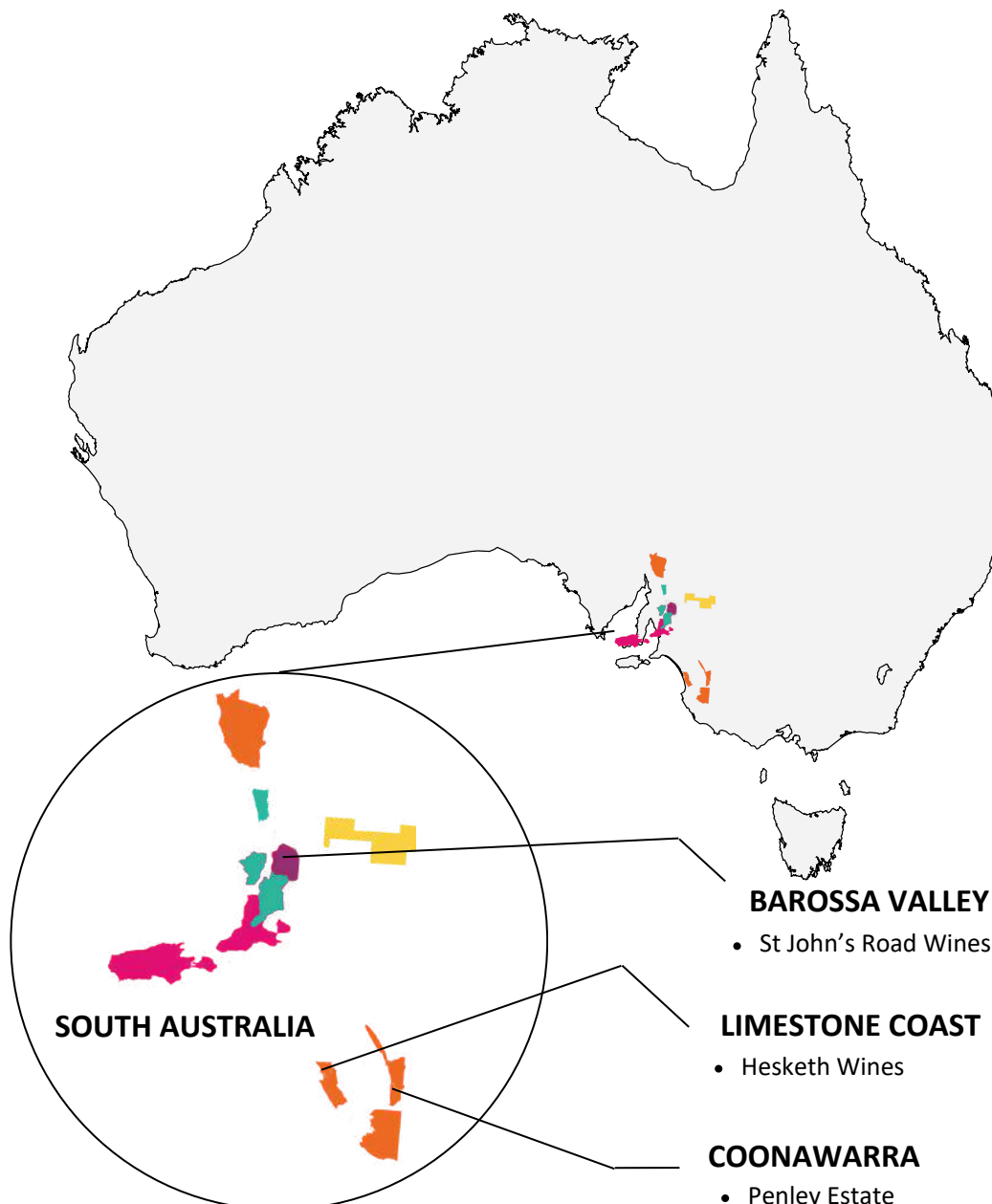
AUSTRALIA

Winegrowing Region



Australia's main vineyard produce is **Shiraz**, followed by **Chardonnay**. The two varieties make up 44% of the total wine production. It gave the country a supporting role on the international wine stage, but great efforts have been made to diversify production in recent years – with Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir and Sauvignon Blanc all now playing a part. On any Australia wine map, the largest wine-producing region by far is South Australia – where half of the nation's vineyards can be found, encouraged by a Mediterranean climate created near the coastal areas.

The best wine regions in Australia are concentrated around the city of Adelaide, including Barossa Valley. The Barossa Valley is arguably the most prestigious wine country in Australia. With a German-influenced wine-growing heritage dating back to 1842, this region in South Australia has some of the world's oldest vineyards and is internationally recognized for its Shiraz. The red clay soil in South Australia's Coonawarra region is Australia's most famous terroir and is perfect for creating exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon styles.



Established in 1988, Penley Estate is one of Coonawarra’s leading wineries, and one of the countries premium growers and makers of Cabernet, Shiraz and red blends. The winery was born from the marriage of two pioneering wine families, the Penfold's and the Tolley's, two pioneering South Australian wine families. Today the estate is owned by 5th generation family members, sisters Ang & Bec Tolley, and like their ancestors they are strong, resilient and determined women.

Established in 2006, the Hesketh Wine Company is a small, family owned producer of high quality, yet accessible wines. They work with their own growers and process their own wines like traditional wineries. Their approach is to remain focused on the individual strengths of different South Australian growing regions.

Specific vineyards – Each wine is either made from a single vineyard or sourced from a small selection of specific vineyards in each region.

House style – Wines are made to a 'Hesketh' style, which is based on balance and complexity but more importantly, 'drinkability'. Wines with generous flavours and aromatics, which also retain a sense of place – wines which reflect the vineyards they are grown in.

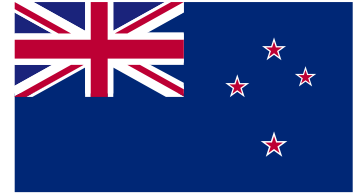

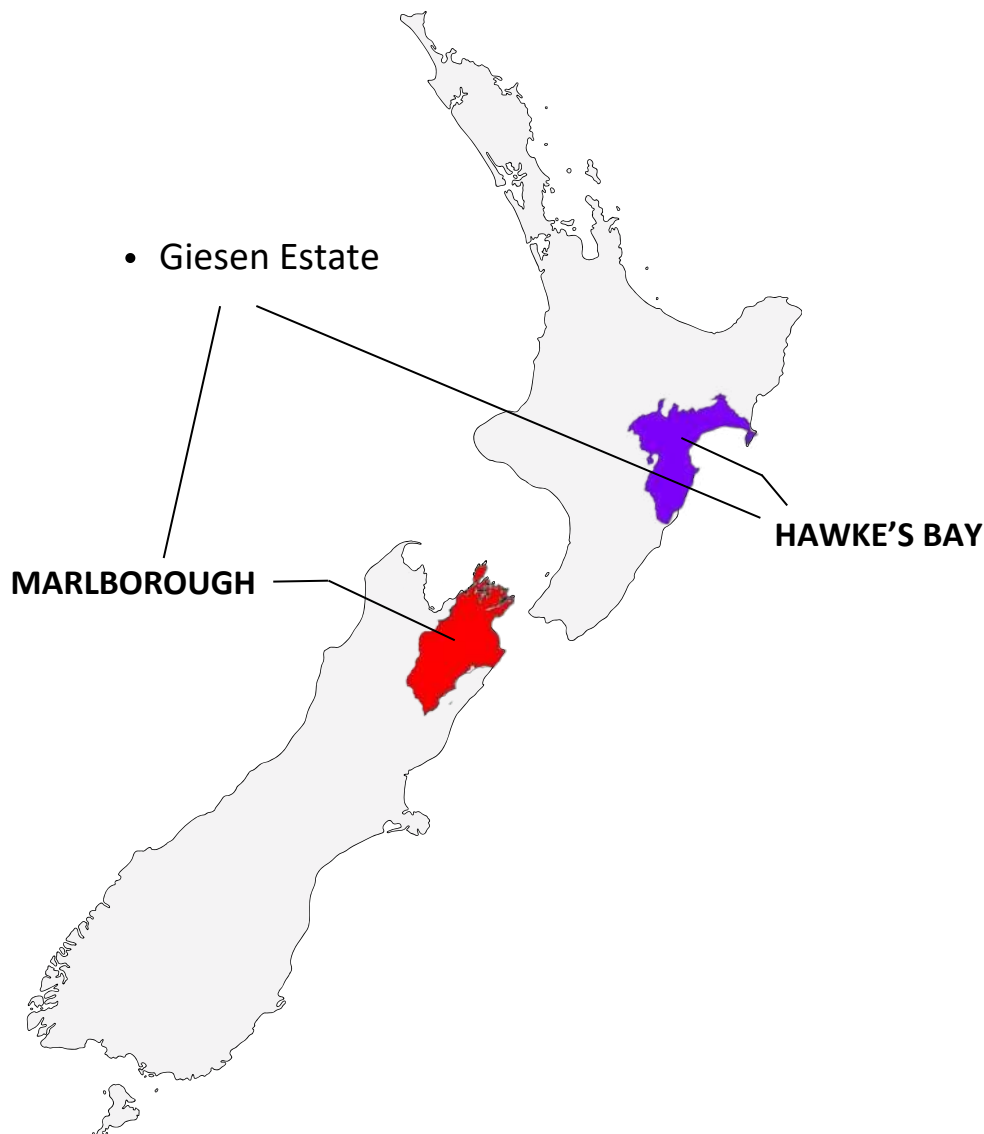


Winegrowing Region

New Zealand reigns as the “**Sauvignon Blanc capital of the world**” with nearly 50,000 acres planted throughout the country. On the whole, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Riesling, and Pinot Gris have accompanied Sauvignon Blanc among New Zealand’s world-class wines that are produced from several distinct regions across the New Zealand wine map. What’s interesting is New Zealand’s unparalleled commitment to sustainability. This is no small feat, considering it's harder to be organic in a cool climate.

Marlborough - Without doubt, the best-known New Zealand wine region, and the one that put them on the international map nearly 30 years ago, thanks to the distinctive expression of Sauvignon Blanc.

Hawke’s Bay - a small region, but an important one! Home to many of the country’s finest wineries. It is the second largest wine-growing region in the country behind Marlborough and produces largely Chardonnay accompanied by some brilliant Syrah. For such a small spot on the New Zealand wine map, the island produces an impressive array of styles.



Founded by brothers Theo, Alex, and Marcel in 1981, family owned Giesen Group of New Zealand has been an industry leader for nearly four decades. Based in Marlborough, the Giesen family produces wine to be enjoyed at every occasion, from their highly awarded organic Clayvin Single Vineyard wines to the widely successful Giesen Estate wines range.


Since 2009 Giesen Wines has made a significant investment in organics, which by 2017 has resulted in 11% of the company's Marlborough vineyards being Certified Organic with BioGro New Zealand. Whilst 11% of their vineyards are certified organic, they are committed to organics philosophy and culture throughout their entire viticulture programme with all of our fruit being sustainably grown.

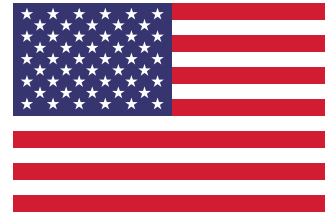

UNITED STATES

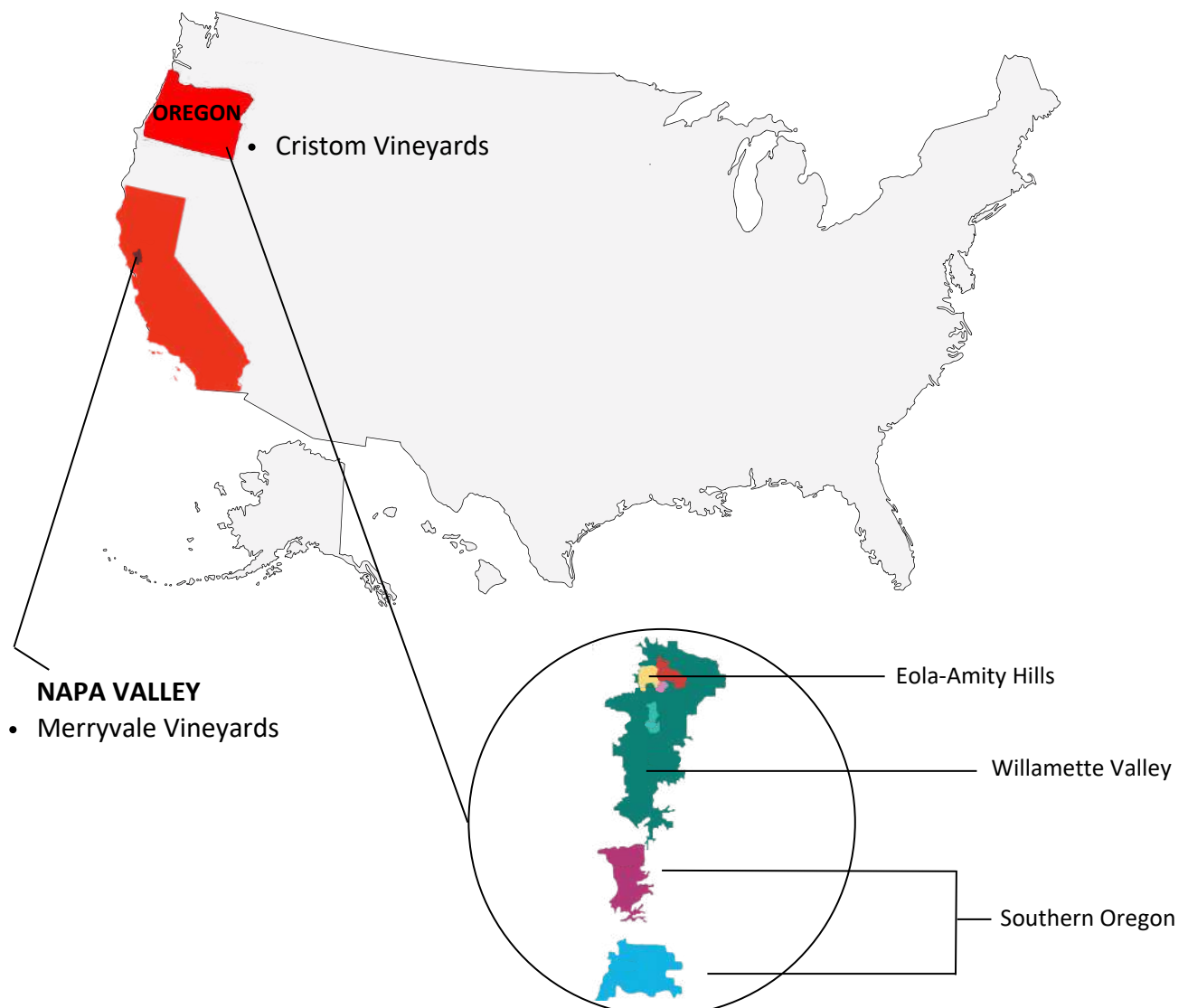
Winegrowing Region



The United States has a short history in winemaking when compared to many other big names, but it's made up for its youth with vigor. The U.S. is 4th worldwide for wine production, and every state has some wineries. **Best known for Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignon.**

The relatively cool and mild climate of the Pacific Northwest makes it the most Europe-like of North America's wine-growing regions. The effects of the cooling marine winds off the Pacific Ocean and the dynamic range of volcanic soils that span our island hill chain in the heart of the Willamette Valley help to define the wines of the Eola-Amity Hills. These high winds translate to cooler temperatures in the Eola-Amity Hills allowing the fruit more time to hang on the vine while retaining bright acidity and fruit aromatics.

Napa Valley is America's most celebrated wine region. It was officially recognized for its high-quality wines and distinctive regional terroir when it became California's first American Viticultural Area (AVA) in 1981. While Napa Valley is mostly known for its prodigious Cabernet Sauvignon production, growing conditions are favorable for a wide range of grapes.



Cristom Vineyards was established in 1992 by the Gerrie family to grow and craft distinguished wines of place that honour individual sites and old-world techniques. Family-owned thirty years later, they remain stewards focused on growing benchmark Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Bringing together biodynamic and organic farming methods, they farm the land with the next 100-years in mind. Their winegrowing centers on the philosophy that the greatest expression of terroir produces the finest wines.

CHILE

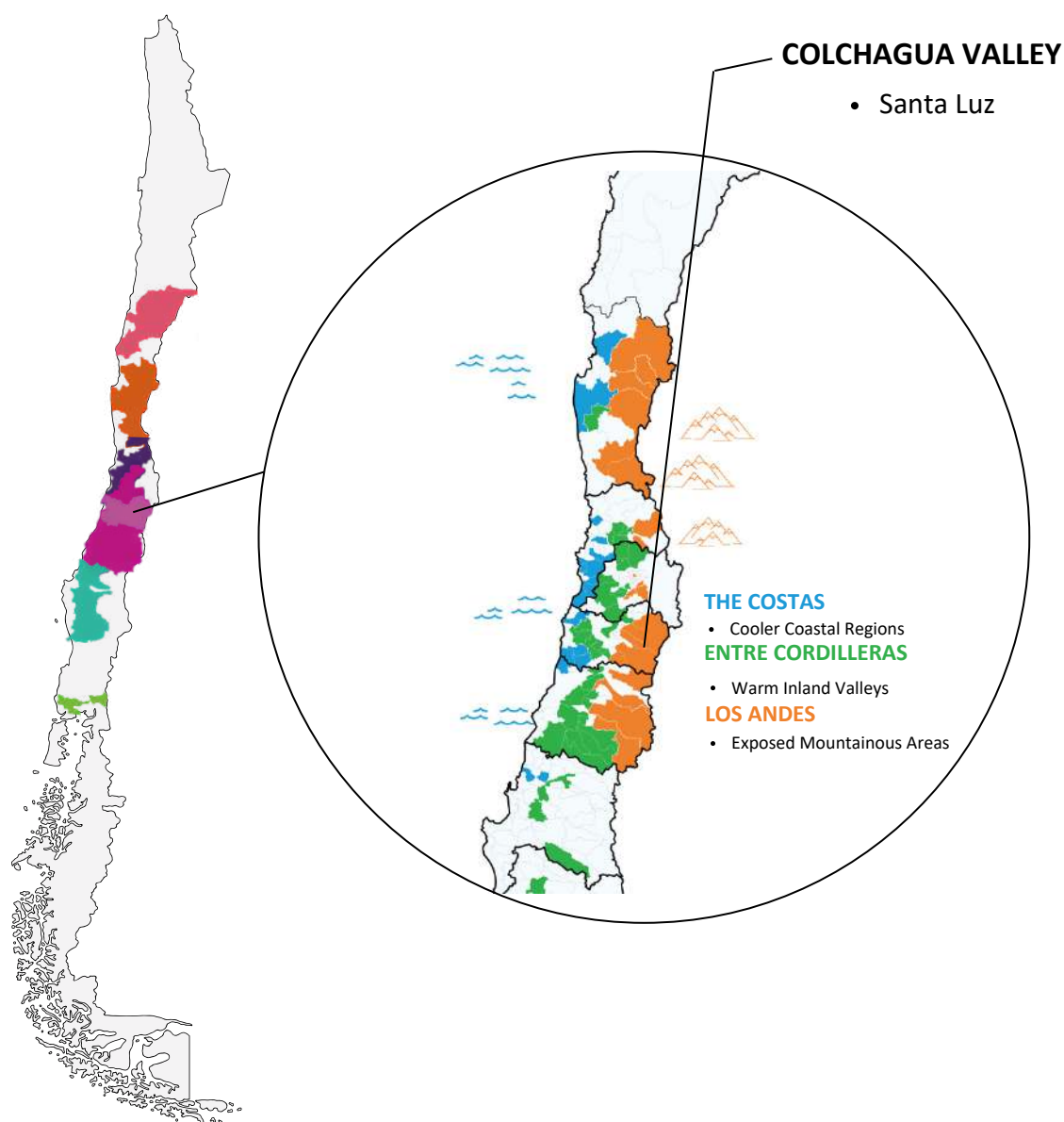


Winegrowing Region

Chile is one of South America's most significant wine producers and possesses a vast range of wine styles grown in a surprising range of terroir for such a small country. Chile is a thin strip of land sandwiched between the Pacific Ocean and the Andes mountains. **Primarily growing Chardonnay and Syrah.**

Its position creates a massive air conditioner effect – sucking cool ocean air inland. Each wine region has 3 unique growing zones: **The Costas, Entre Cordilleras** and **Los Andes**. The coastal regions are best suited for cool-climate grapes like Pinot Noir and Chardonnay; Sauvignon Blanc grows well here too! The inland valleys are warmest and known for their soft and supple Bordeaux Blends. The high-elevation Andes create wines with more structure (tannin and acidity) and this has led to intriguing Syrah, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon.

The French were excited by the prospects of Chile's ideal climate and soils for fine wines and invested in the region early on. Their influence shaped Chile's wine market towards a focus on Bordeaux varieties like Merlot and Cabernet, focusing heavily on exports.

Established in 1936, Vina Luis Felipe Edwards is undeniably one of the most progressive wineries in Chile. Always keen to invest in land, technology and people, the Colchagua Valley based operation sits nestled amongst the Alamos trees, separated from the colossal Andes by the smaller San Fernando ridge. The winery produces over 3 million cases (9lt) per year and exports to over 100 countries, making it a major global player. Luis Felipe Edwards remains a family run operation, allowing greater control to ensure that the LFE brand name is synonymous with quality and traditional family values.

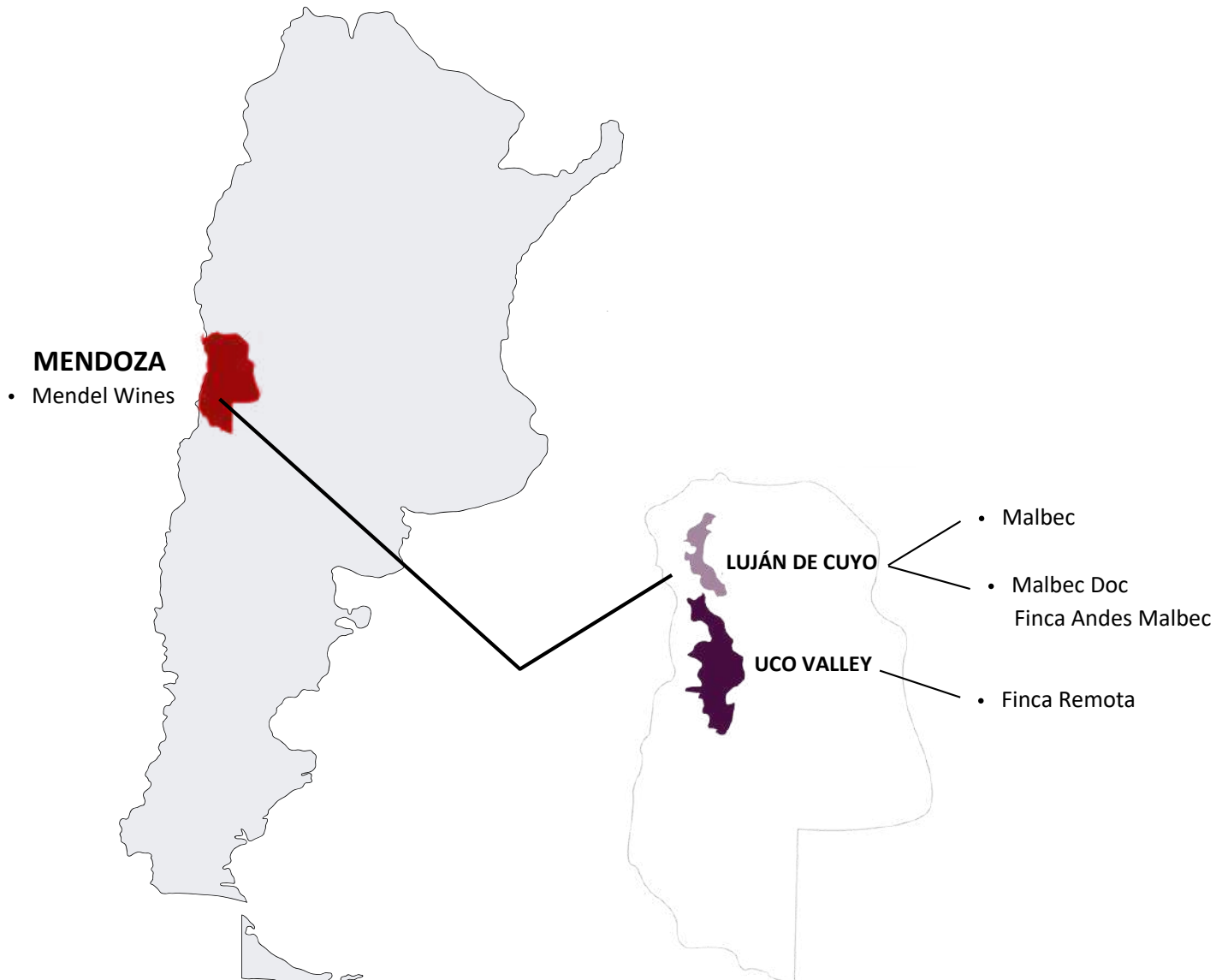
ARGENTINA

Winegrowing Region



If you love **Malbec**, Argentina is your ultimate wine region. Argentina has the highest altitude vineyards in the world and is renowned for its supply Malbec wines that range from affordable to ultra-high-end. Mendoza is the largest, and most important wine region, accounting for 75% of Argentina's vineyards.

Red wines are the focus here and certain areas stand out above the rest in terms of quality. For example, the sub-regions of **Maipú, Luján de Cuyo and Uco Valley** have the highest elevations. This means that grapes have increased sun exposure resulting in thicker skins and wines that are not only well-structured and fruit-forward but concentrated. It is these characteristics that put Argentina on the map through their **Malbec** — a red wine with dark fruit flavors and a smoky finish.



Mendel wines classically combine Roberto de la Mota’s prestigious winemaking skills and tremendously old vineyards to make Mendoza’s most elegant wines. Proprietor and long-time wine lover, Anabelle Sielecki, partnered with Roberto to transform her family’s historic 1928 vineyard into the respected estate it is today. She honors her father, a hardworking immigrant and successful businessman, by putting his first name, Mendel, on the label.

Using his French winemaking experience, Roberto has led Argentina’s winemaking movement toward world-class production. The finesse and elegance in his wines are revered and respected.

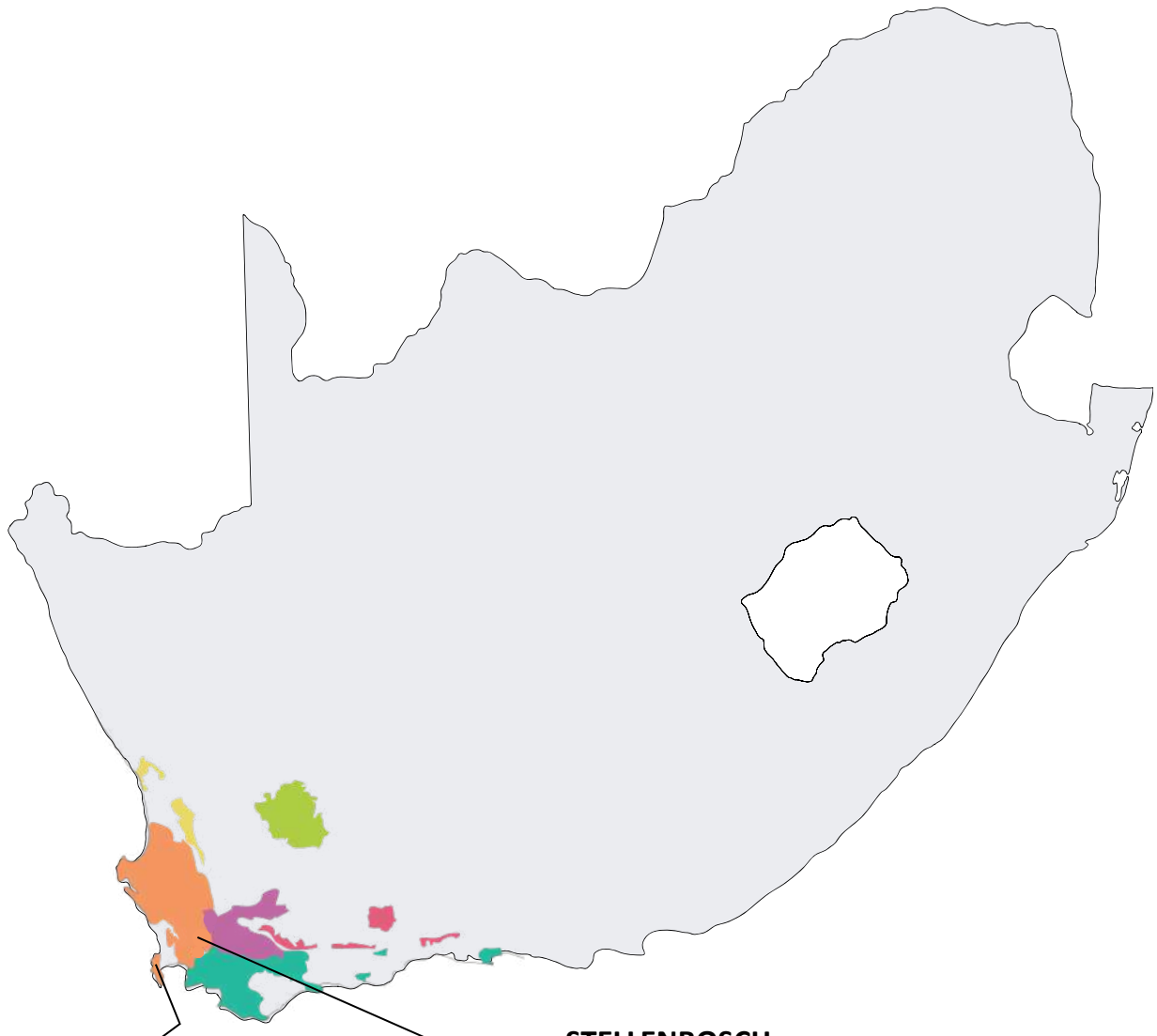

Explore the most significant examples of **Old World meets New World**. What makes South Africa unique is its warm climate paired with ancient granite soils (over 600 million years old) which results in bold red and white wines with high aromatic intensity.

Did you know? Stellenbosch is the birthplace of **Pinotage**, South Africa's very own grape variety. Created in 1925, Pinotage is a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsault. Its notoriety began when Kanonkop Pinotage won the Robert Mondavi Trophy for the Best Red Wine at the '91 International Wine and Spirits Competition in London.

Plus, South Africa produced one of the world's most famous wines during the early 1700 (before Cabernet Sauvignon became famous!). The country's Chenin Blanc-based dessert wine, Constantia, was famous across Europe. Today the story is changing. South African wines have emerged as both some of the best-valued red and white wines and of the highest quality. If you love Cabernet Sauvignon, start looking for South Africa's hot values!

Kanonkop is a 4th generation family-owned wine estate, renowned for its red wines, with Pinotage making up 50% of all plantings. Their Pinotage vines were some of the first commercially planted Pinotage to be established in the Cape and most are over 50 years old. Optimum ripeness plays a major role in producing good red wine and on the estate a careful check is done to ensure that the grapes are picked at perfection.

Winemaking at Kanonkop follows the age-old tradition of being made in open concrete fermenters, but with a slight difference, the tanks are wide and shallow, rather high and deep. All cellaring, bottling and labelling is done on Kanonkop.

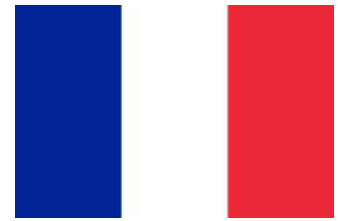

FRANCE

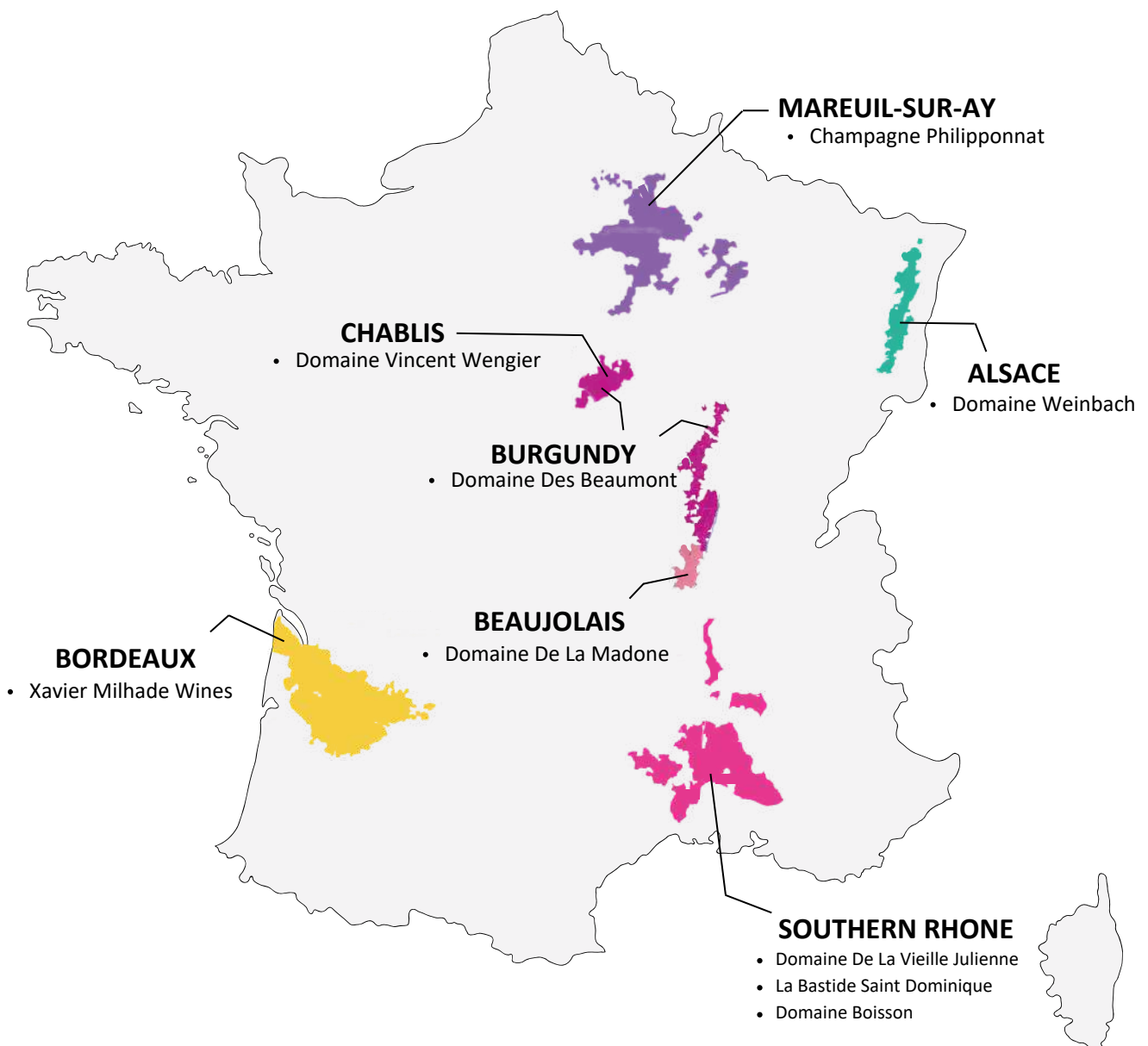
Winegrowing Region



France is a country synonymous with fine wine and as any map of French wine regions will show, there are vineyards scattered throughout the country that are responsible for producing between seven and eight billion bottles a year.

While even the most elementary wine drinker will recognize the likes of **Bordeaux**, **Burgundy** and **Champagne** through their historic winemaking traditions, wines are commercially produced in every region of France except those along the north coast. Nonetheless, France produces over 3,000 different wines across two million hectares of vineyards.

Generally speaking, the French wine region's map can be divided into northern vineyards that are reputed for white wines, and southern vineyards (with the exception of the Jura and Savoy) that are more renowned for their reds. The main wine areas of the French wine region map are Bordeaux, Burgundy, Languedoc, Champagne, the Loire Valley, Alsace, Rhône, Provence and Corsica.



Philipponnat is a historic French Champagne house owned by the family of the same name, whose wine history in the region dates back to 16th Century when the family's work as negotiators and merchants supplied wine to the court of Louis XIV.

Although the family can trace its Champagne roots back to 1522, the modern house was founded in 1910 by Pierre Philipponnat, and is now run by Charles Philipponnat. It is a small but highly respected Champagne house, producing only about 650,000 bottles of Champagne, from the Brut Royale Reserve, the true ambassador of the House, to its famous single-plot-vineyard Champagne: Clos des Goisses.

Vincent Wengier is a fourth-generation Chablis winemaker who, along with his wife, Sophie, has produced wine under his name since 2018. Domaine Vincent Wengier was first established in 1950 and is located in the southwest region of the appellation, in the village of Prehy, two hours southeast of Paris.

The Wengiers manage 27 hectares of vines, spread over four appellations. They hold HVE (high environmental value) certification to promote fauna and flora within the vineyard. Their careful attention to detail in the vineyards has also earned them organic certification.

Domaine de la Madone is located in the heart of Beaujolais in the Beaujolais Villages area. The vineyard spreads over 28 ha over two villages, Le Perréon and Vaux en Beaujolais (better known as “Clochemerle”). The estate is divided into 90 small plots of different exposures and altitudes (between 300 and 500 m). With vines ranging from 15 years to more than 100 years (40 years old on average). Gamay is planted on South facing steep slopes on pink granite soils; this diversity of terroirs is key to enable the Beraerd brothers to craft complex wines with depth and soul. On the Northern facing slopes, one can find the estates parcels of Chardonnay, this grape expressing more elegance on those more clay soils. A part of the estate (2.5 ha) is now fully organic while the rest is trained using sustainable viticulture methods.

DOMAINE WEINBACH

Domaine Weinbach is an icon of the Alsace wine region, a pioneer of biodynamic viticulture and winemaking, and producer of some of the world's greatest aromatic wines. Located the foot of the majestic Schlossberg hill, Domaine Weinbach is a "stream of wine", named after the small brook that traverses the vineyard, it, was built in 1612 by the Capuchin monks.

The estate has been in the Faller family since 1898, which produces mainly Grand Cru. The fame may go to the imposing Schlossberg GC but equal renown should be extended to the walled Clos de Capucins that surrounds the winery and the Furstentum GC, celebrated for exceptional Gewurztraminer. Viticulture has been organic for many years but a conversion to biodynamics culminated in certification for the 2006 vintage onwards.

Founded in 1905, this estate has been owned and run by the Daumen family ever since. Domaine de la Vieille Julienne is located in the northern end of the Châteauneuf-du-Pape appellation, in sector known as Le Grès. Since 1990, when Jean-Paul Daumen took over from his father, he converted to biodynamic farming in 1998.

Low yields are the goal at Vieille Julienne. They are often under 20 hectoliters per hectare, which gives the wine a lot of its power, purity and concentration. The grapes are de-stemmed before alcoholic fermentation and all grapes are co-fermented. Aging takes place in a combination of foudres and old, oak barrels.

The origins of the property date back to the mid 19th Century when the farm was made up of different cultures (meadow, garden, cereals, olive trees, vines, etc.). After WWII, René Boisson (Bruno's grandfather) developed the business. Following the 1956 frost, he decided to replace the frozen olive trees with vines and bought a 10 hectare wood in Lardage-Paréol to cultivate. In 1957, René Boisson left the Cave Coopérative to create his own cellar.

Le Pompon is a tribute to the last Mule of the estate belonging to Bruno's grandfather, it was used to plough the vineyards, carry the harvest and many other things at the time, once the first tractors arrived at the estate it was replaced but that faithful hard working companion still remains in our hearts and minds.

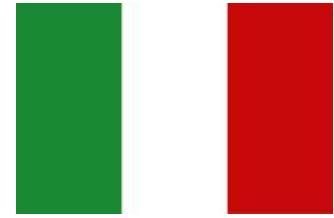

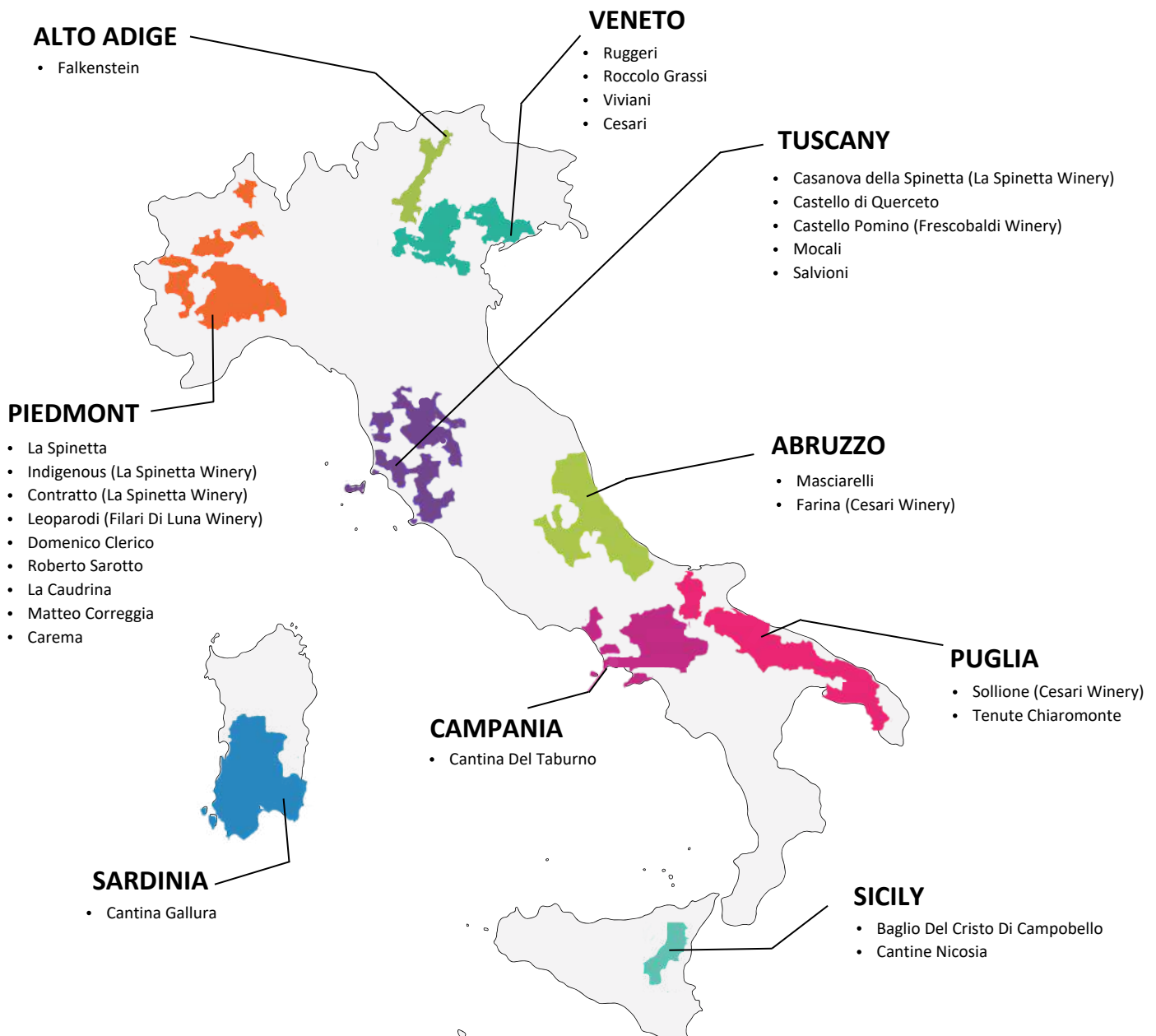
Winegrowing Region



Italian wine is one of the most difficult regions to get to know.

Why? Well for one, the Italians use an esoteric wine labeling system, much like the French. With more than 350 official wine varieties and 20 different wine-producing regions, there are 3 major regions that produce high-quality wines and they are: **Veneto, Tuscany, and Piedmont!**

There are some key DOCGs sought after by wine lovers around the globe, such as Barolo, Barbaresco and Brunello di Montalcino, and other well-recognized wines like Amarone della Valpolicella, Prosecco, Chianti, Soave and Franciacorta, there are plenty of new wines from the center and the south gaining in popularity – Primitivo, Nero d'Avola and Verdicchio to name just a few. Nearly all of Italy's wine regions hide some little-known varieties, just waiting to be discovered, and a new wave of winemakers keen to discover this wealth of local varieties is now emerging.



Founded in 1977 by Giuseppe (“Pin”) and Lidia Rivetti, La Spinetta was first known for their production of excellent single-vineyard Moscato d’Asti wines. It is now particularly known for its single-vineyard Barbaresco wines and the Barolo Campe, plus an innovative blend of Nebbiolo and Barbera called Pin.

The Rivetti family believes passionately in the exclusive use of indigenous grapes and in a style that is individual and distinct from what they see as a globalisation of character and taste. They believe in intensive vineyard work, very low yields (17-20 hl/ha), no use of chemicals, pesticides or fertilizers, extensive green harvesting, and in extremely carefully chosen vineyards.

Known as one of the progressive "Barolo Boys", Domenico sought out the best undiscovered plots in Barolo, thus pioneering the idea of single cru wines. In addition to his devotion to single cru vineyards, Domenico championed what is considered a modern style of Barolo, using new burgundy barrels and later barriques to age the wines.

Today, Domenico Clerico is one of the most respected names in all Barolo, and his wines are renowned for both winemaking of the highest quality and for their exceptional expression of terroir.

The wines of Roero have always lived in the shadow of Barolo, but the Correggia winery is a beacon of light. The renowned Falkenstein winery, owned by the Pratzner family for 400 years, is located on the orographic left of Val Venosta, on the so-called Rocca del Falco, which dominates the town of Naturno from above.

The company is located close to Mount Sonnenberg and extends with its 12 hectares of vineyards on a hill in a sunny area at 650 meters above sea level. The particular climate, with hot days and cool nights, lends itself perfectly to the cultivation of the Weissburgunder varieties (Pinot Blanc), Blauburgunder (Pinot Noir), Sauvignon and Gewürztraminer, but above all Riesling, so much so that Falkenstein's Riesling is considered one of the best in southern Germany.



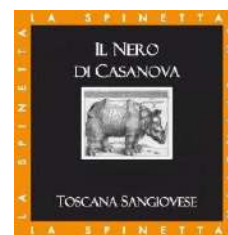

Giorgio Rivetti's magic touch with Moscato, Barbera and Nebbiolo in Piedmont took the world by storm. In 2000, he acquired a Tuscan estate, Casanova della Spinetta, located in the hills south of Pisa where the vineyards enjoy the strong summer sun and the soft breezes wafting off the nearby Mediterranean Sea.

Salvioni owns La Cerbaiola vineyard in the southeast of the commune, a plot universally recognised as one of the great 'crus' of the village. Here tradition is king. Aging can be as short as the required two years, or even longer if the vintage allows for it.

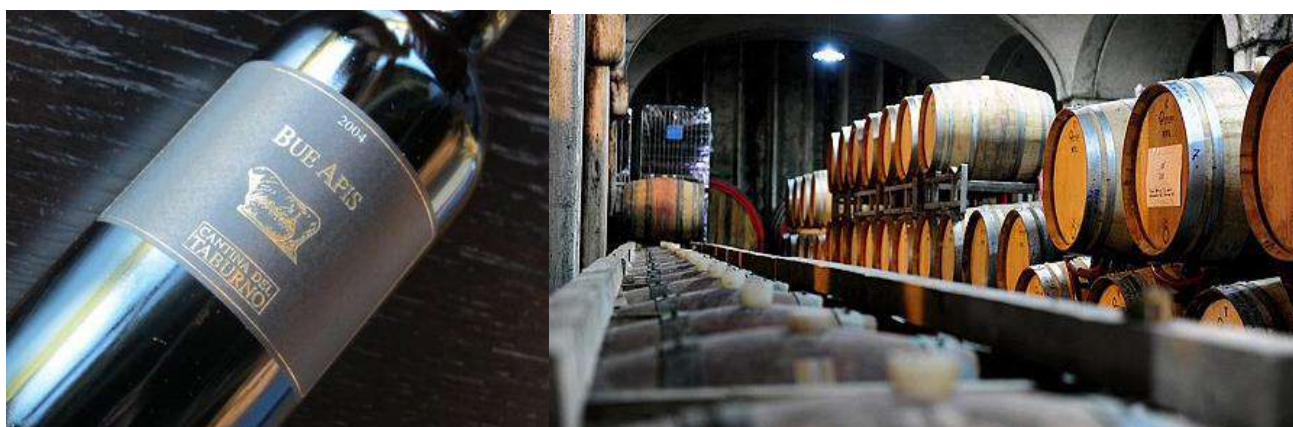

The grapes are destemmed, then fed by gravity into tanks where they are left to ferment in whole clusters with their yeasts before they are crushed in hand-crank presses.

BAGLIO DEL CRISTO DI CAMPOBELLO

The Baglio del Cristo di Campobello project is a visionary one, as its creators, Angelo, Domenico and Carmelo Bonetta, launched it in order to successfully bottle "Sicilianity". This ambitious idea was supported by the invaluable contribution of Riccardo Cotarella, one of Italy's most important enologists. The winery, which is very modern as it was renovated 12 years ago, immediately focused on enhancing the characteristics of an area with a high potential: the chalky limestone hills south of the town of Campobello di Licata.

The vines grow all around the estate, on gentle hills of chalky limestone, at an altitude of 300 metres in the Campobello countryside. The climate in summer is the scorching one typical of the Sicilian hinterland, although softened here by cool breezes coming from the nearby Sicilian Channel. Grillo, Chardonnay, Nero d'Avola, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot grapes ripen on this beautiful soil. The first harvest was only in 2007, however, in just a few years the winery has been able to establish itself not only on the Sicilian wine scene, but also throughout Italy.

The Cantina Sociale Gallura is located in the town of Tempio Pausania on the foothills of Mount Limbara. This cooperative was founded in 1956 and it currently has 160 producers contributing their grapes. The total area of planted vineyards is about 600 acres. The soil, a mix of sand and rock, is poor, and the vines have to struggle to survive this hostile environment. The limited grape yield offers unique and prized qualities. Most of the properties are planted with Vermentino, Nebbiolo and Moscato varietals.

The strict selection systems, modern winemaking process and aging in barrels, they produce high quality wines with organoleptic characteristics attuned to the changing tastes and needs of consumers. Spearhead of the Cantina Gallura is the "Vermentino di Gallura", the only wine in Sardinia awarded, since 1996, of the aspired Denomination of Origin Controlled and Guaranteed.

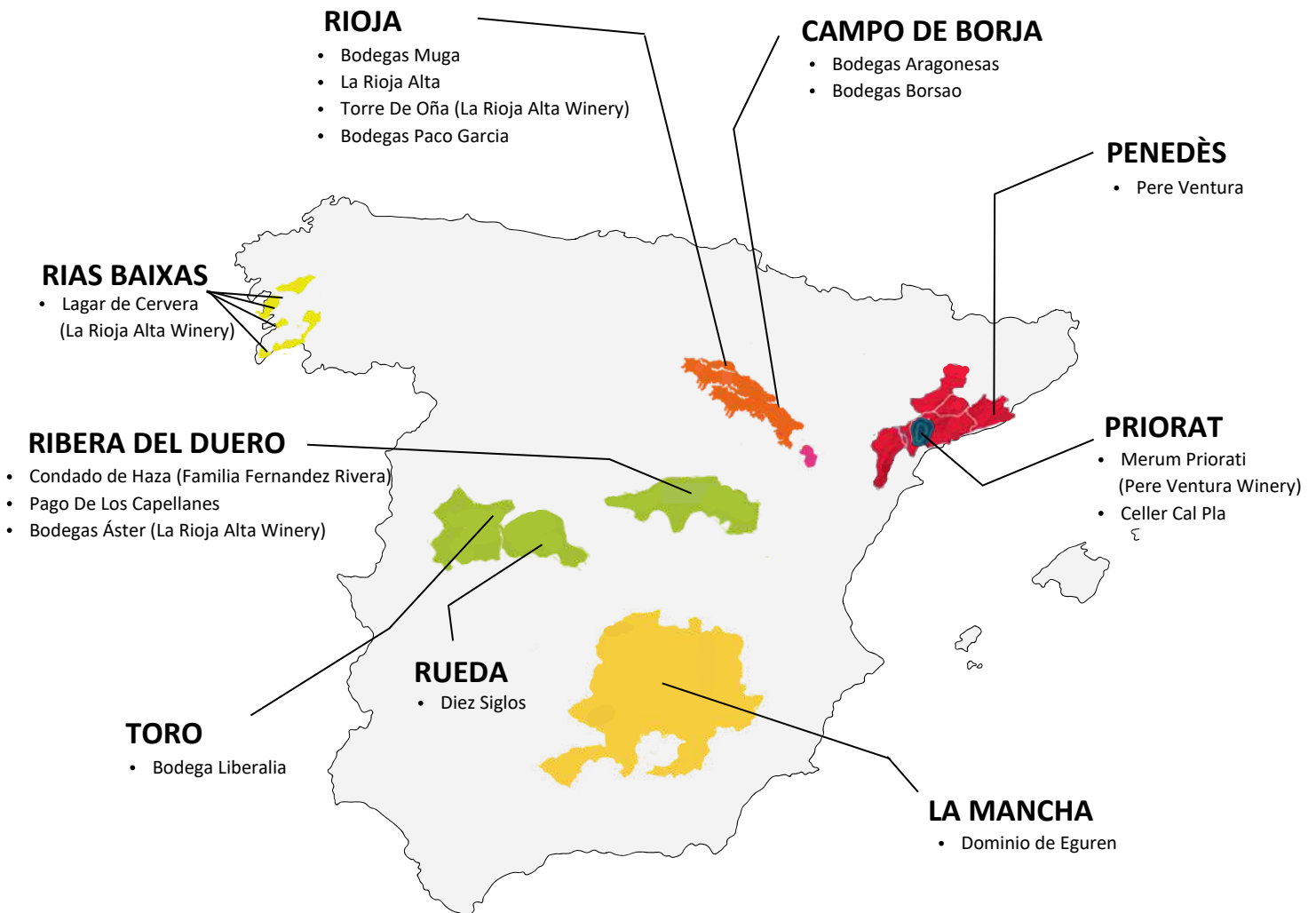

Winegrowing Region

Spain, the third-largest wine producer globally with over one million acres of the country covered in vineyards, each showcasing unique viticultural treasures. There are 69 officially recognized wine regions in Spain. The mainstream areas are referred to as Denominaciones de Origen D.O, which are similar to France's appellations, and the wine produced here is carefully regulated for quality according to specific laws.

Prominent among them is the iconic **Rioja**, famed for its exceptional Tempranillo-based wines. Aragon, though less known, has recently gained recognition for its quality wines, particularly those from Somontano DO and the delightful Garnacha wines from Campo de Borja, Calatayud, and Cariñena DOs. From the effervescent Cava in Penedès to the robust Priorat and the crisp Albariño wines of Rías Baixas, Spain's wine regions offer a remarkable wine adventure.



Pere Ventura's family heritage with Cava dates back to 1872, when his great grandfather, Manuel Montserrat Font, helped produced the first bottles of Cava at Codorniu. The family-based PERE VENTURA FAMILY WINE ESTATES produces and markets its own wines and cavas (sparkling wines), which are known worldwide for their great quality and prestige.

All Pere Ventura Cavas undergo the "Traditional Method" of sparkling wine production, the same method used for Champagne. Grapes are hand harvested and de-stemmed before they undergo a first fermentation in stainless steel tanks at a temperature of 61°F to 64°F. The juice is then clarified and stabilized before undergoing secondary fermentation which takes place in the bottle. The wine is riddled, disgorged and the dosage is added before the bottle is sealed. The minimum aging is 14 months.

MERUM PRIORATI (PERE VENTURA WINERY)

THE ELITE OF PRIORAT - Merum Priorati, located in Porrera, is one of the most important wine estates in Priorat, founded in 2004 by two Catalan families, and located in the east of the appellation around the pretty village of Porrera.

The three vineyard plots (Les Foreses, Plana Marjot and Les Escomelles) cover a total of 103 hectares, but just 29ha are given over to vines, as this is one of the wildest, most rugged terrains where few vines thrive and those that do produce less than 1 kg of grapes per vine (and as low as 250g per vine for the older Garnacha and Cariñena plants). Impeccably made but not over polished, wines are truly hand-made: fermentation is in small, open top vats with long cuvasion, delivering wines which are intense and seriously complex against a backdrop of bright and vibrant modern fruit.

The winery has earned gold in all the international competitions in which it has participated since 2018. Grenaches du Monde and Gilbert & Gaillard thus join Decanter World Wine Awards, Mundus Vini, Sakura-Japan Women's Wine Award and Berliner Wein Trophy. The wines are also garnering recognition from professionals in the industry, such as the renowned sommelier Andreas Larsson (Blind Tasted), who also gave them a rating over 90 points.

CELLER CAL PLA

The Sangenis family, one of the oldest grape-growing families in Catalan DOQ Priorat, historically sold their grapes to the local cooperative. In 1996, Joan Sangenis completed his oenology studies, and began Celler Cal Pla to bottle under their own label.

Based in the village of Porrera in Priorat, they own 20 hectares of south facing vineyards (at an altitude of 300-400m and topsoil called Llicorella) with an average age of 50 years and several small parcels of 100+ year old vines of Garnacha and Carignan. Farming is done organically, harvesting is by hand.

Bodegas Aragonesas was founded in 1984 when several cooperatives in the Campo de Borja region decided to unite to market the wines they were producing. The intervening years have seen this winery grow in prestige and recognition globally due to their Coto de Hayas brand, their star variety Garnacha used in the production of many wines, often originating from extremely old grapevines, and the careful management of their extensive vineyards has not gone unnoticed either.

This bodegas is the biggest producer from Campo de Borja, Aragon and they own the largest Old Vines - between 40-100+ years old -Garnacha in the world (1500 hectares) making them unique and impossible to compare to any other wine region.

BODEGAS MUGA

Bodegas Muga is a family-owned wine estate, founded in 1932 in the Rioja region of Spain. It is particularly known for its traditional style Reserva wines that are only produced in vintages of utmost quality.

The famous bodega has approximately 250 hectares (617 acres) of vineyards around Rioja a majority of which are around the town of Haro where the winery is based. Fruit for the top wines tends to come from the family's original Baltracones vineyard, where the chalky, alluvial soils are well-suited to Tempranillo and Garnacha. Oak is important in the winemaking process – Muga is one of the few producers in Spain with its own cooperage.

La Rioja Alta is one of the oldest winery that founded in 1890 by a consortium of five families. They combines tradition and innovation in its approach to winemaking. They practise hand harvesting and sold unsuitable berries to large wineries for simpler wines.

What sets this bodega apart from other traditionalists is that the wines succeed in retaining striking vigour and fruit whilst undergoing their lengthy period in cask. They are released for sale only when fully ready to drink and always have an air of graceful maturity about them.

La Rioja Alta does its own coopering in house. Oak raw materials are purchased in the United States and slowly processed in our own cooperage, including "aging" of boards in the open air for two years and burning of barrels.

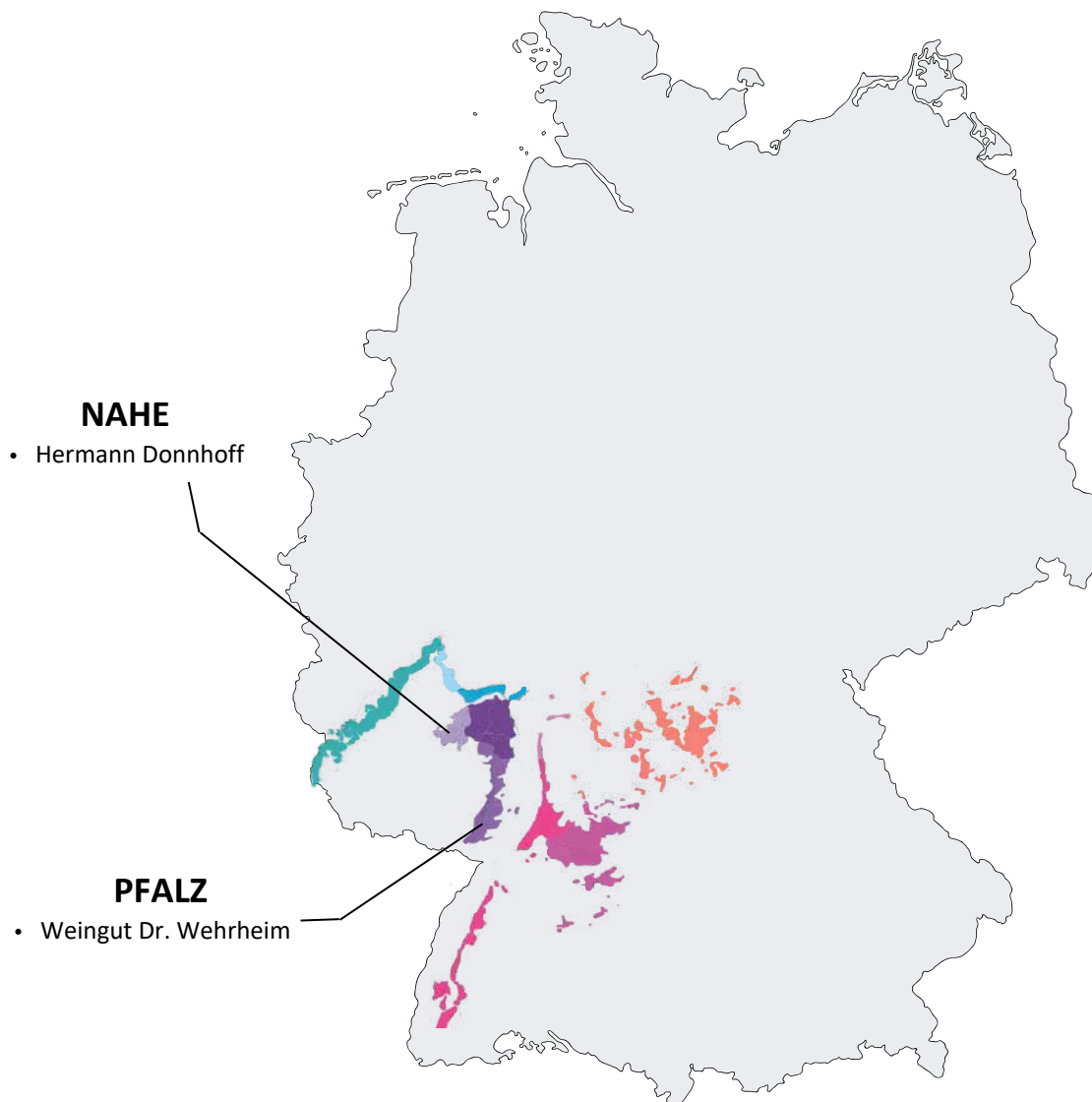

Winegrowing Region

What sets Austria apart is that it has made its name from one indigenous grape variety -**Grüner Veltliner**, Austria's national grape varietal. It is not a piece of news to wine insiders. They both have a similar weightiness and with age, Grüner Veltliner turns round and powerful with a texture that could be similar to Chardonnay.

Austria is made up of nine federal states and viticulture is concentrated in four of them: Lower Austria (Niederösterreich), Vienna, Burgenland, and Styria. Niederösterreich, located northeast of Austria, is the country's largest wine region. It is also the largest quality wine-growing area with eight of the 16 official wine regions (also half of the total production). Grüner Veltliner and Riesling are by far the two main grape varieties.

The soils here are very diverse. One finds Mica-schist in the Bohemian massif in the Kamptal region, but also bedrock weathered soils, covered with a thin coating of humus. The heart of Heiligenstein, an almost ideal partner for top-class Rieslings is a weathered desert sandstone from the Permian. Grüner Veltliner thrives on the gravel soils of Manhartsberg or the partly massive loess deposits that characterize the southern borders of this wine region.

KAMPTAL (NIEDERÖSTERREICH)

- Weingut Schloss Gobelsburg



Schloss Gobelsburg's history traces back to 1171, when the Cistercian monks of the Zwettle monastery acquired their first two vineyards (wines are still made from these single sites today). The castle and its vineyards were added in the eighteenth century, the main building soon after receiving its Baroque transformation on the instructions of one of its many illustrious owners.

As well as Austria's earliest recorded vines, Schloss Gobelsburg can boast a dedication to organic farming that long precedes any modern trends, eschewing chemicals where possible and letting the land speak for itself. Its agriculture is now certified as sustainable, with as little mechanical reliance in the winery as possible.
